

Work-Study-funding for international students of IFBC, SIA, and SUSFood

Dear international students,

the Faculty of Organic Agricultural Sciences (University of Kassel) has generated funding defined on programmes for the improvement of the integration of foreign students into the research activities of the different departments including those of the partner universities Göttingen and Fulda that are actively involved in teaching of the international MSc programs IFBC, SIA, and SUSFood. In order to achieve this, special funds are allocated to students as small work grants for work in research groups of up to 300 € (about 21/25 working hours depending on your degree status). The idea behind this programme is that while the research group is provided with the work time of the student, the student gains direct supervision and introduction into particular laboratory or other research work. This offers the chance to the student to familiarise him/her with the research structures and to possibly find further employment.

Availability: 20 grants per year

Eligibility: Foreign students of the IFBC, SIA, and SUSFood programmes who do not receive other grants.

Procedure: After admission to the programme, student finds her/himself a research group willing to integrate her/him as a student worker into the research group for 1 semester until end of March and September, resp., each year.

Application period: 1 to 30 October and 1 to 30 April each year. Please apply by answering within the period the questionnaire at
