Less inequalities in the plant cocoa (Goal 10)

Audio- Lyrics:

Do you know that Germany and Switzerland are the largest chocolate consumers in Europe ? We roughly eat 90 bars of chocolate per year. A lot of cocoa beans are transported from African countries like Ghana and the Ivory Coast. Even though cocoa beans are shipped from countries which are far away we can buy chocolate for little money in the supermarket. But the workers in Africa are paid very badly. Only 7% of the income goes to the workers and 10% to the producing countries. A company receives around 35% of the revenues and a supermarket even more. That's why Goal 10 deals with the topic "Less inequalities in the plant cocoa". Goal 10 should reduce inequalities between the countries, but to achieve this political measures are necessary. It has only happened in voluntary cases so far, e.g. through seals like "Fair Trade" or "GEPA". These seals guarantee the workers in Africa solid prices, a right to get paid vacation and a social provision giving them the chance to work under certified conditions.
