

Workshop on Logic in Computer Science – LogInf 2014, Kassel

Theoretical Computer Science / Formal Methods (FMV), University of Kassel

Arrival in Kassel.

Kassel has good train connections to the north and south and east, and reasonable ones to the west. If you arrive by train, use the station *Kassel-Wilhelmshöhe* rather than *Kassel Hbf*, it is nearer to the university, it is served by long-distance trains (ICE, IC), and it has good public transport connections to anything else in Kassel.

From the station take tram 1 (to *Vellmar*) or 3 (to *Ihringshäuser Str.*) and get off at the 4th stop at *Murhardstr./ Universität*. A short-trip ticket (“Kurzstrecke”) suffices for this. Ticket machines can be found on the tram.

Alternatively, you can walk down Wilhelmshöher Allee – the main street in front of the train station – for about 15min to get to the university.

When you get off the tram from *Wilhelmshöhe* you look straight onto the building's entrance C.

At the university.

Follow the signs inside the building to get to the lecture hall -1319 in which the workshop will be held. It is located on floor -1 (basement) of part 3 of the building.

The FMV group resides in offices 1311 – 1319 on the first floor of part 3 of the building, see the map below.

Internet Access.

The network *eduroam* is available on the university's premises.


Lunches / Dinner.

There is a *Mensa* and a cafeteria in the university's buildings (in the yellow part on the map below). On Friday evening there will be a workshop dinner at the restaurant Karl's (<http://www.restaurant-karls-hospital.de/>) starting at 7:30pm. It is located on Weserstr. 2A, between the tram stops *Altmarkt* and *Katzensprung/Universität*. Maps of the tram and bus network can be found here: <http://www.kvg.de/index.php?id=408>.

To get to the restaurant you can take tram 3 (direction *Ihringshäuser Str.*) in front of the university at the stop *Murhardstr./Universität* which takes you directly to *Altmarkt*. Then turn left into *Weserstr.* The restaurant is about 100m down the road on the right side, set back from the road against the river Fulda. Alternatively, you can take tram 1 from the university and change onto tram 3/4/6/8 at *Königsplatz*, continuing into the same direction. If you are staying at a hotel north of the university you can also take tram 7 from stop *Goethestr.* or trams 4/8 from stops like *Stadthalle*, *Bebelplatz* or *Friedenskirche* to *Altmarkt*.

Maps.
