- If you register for the exam and then cannot participate, you can withdraw via HISPOS/eCampus up until the day before the exam takes place. If your cancellation is on the day of the exam, you must inform me (Matt Emery) by email and contact the Prüfungsamt. You will need to submit a doctor's certificate to the Prüfungssekretariat within three days.
- All candidates may use one monolingual English dictionary if they wish. Please
 note that a thesaurus is not a dictionary and that electronic dictionaries are not
 permitted. We will not allow you to share dictionaries, and we will not provide them
 either.
- Any electronic devices (such as mobile phones, smartwatches, bluetooth-enabled devices etc.) must be switched off completely and placed in your bag at the front of the room before the exam begins. Please note that if you are caught in possession of such a device during the exam, this will be considered cheating regardless of what you were doing with it.
- Wearing a mask inside the building, including during the exam itself, is strongly recommended.
