## Who can apply?

- All students of the University of Kassel who are at least in their third semester at the beginning of their studies abroad can apply for the Erasmus+ programme (programme type 'Study'). For Master's degree programmes, an Erasmus stay abroad is possible from the 1st semester onwards.
- The maximum number of 12 funding months under the Erasmus+ Programme (study and work placements) per study phase (BA, MA, PhD) cannot be exceeded.

## Application Process

### Step 1 – Get information

- Inform yourself about our Erasmus+ [partner universities](#) early on and check out the homepages of the respective Universities.

### Step 2 – Get advice if needed

- in the office hours of the [Team Internationales FB05](#): we will be happy to help you with an initial overview and orientation and refer you to the relevant contact persons
- by the cooperation officers of the Faculty 05: advice on all subject-related questions (courses offered, credit transfer at the University of Kassel, Learning Agreements), as well as on the application process
- at the International Office: advises on forms of funding and non-subject-specific aspects of your stay abroad (Erasmus+ includes a country-specific scholarship)

### Step 3 – Apply

Places are awarded by the cooperation officers of the Department 05. The International Office is responsible for the further organisational processing and payment of the Erasmus+ scholarship.

- Please contact the responsible cooperation officer for more information about the documents required for application (e.g. letter of motivation, HIS printout, curriculum vitae, current certificate of study, ...), the required documents vary depending on the partner university.
- Then fill out the [online application](#) of the International Office and have it signed by the responsible cooperation officer. To officially complete your nomination, the signed application will be forwarded to the International Office.
