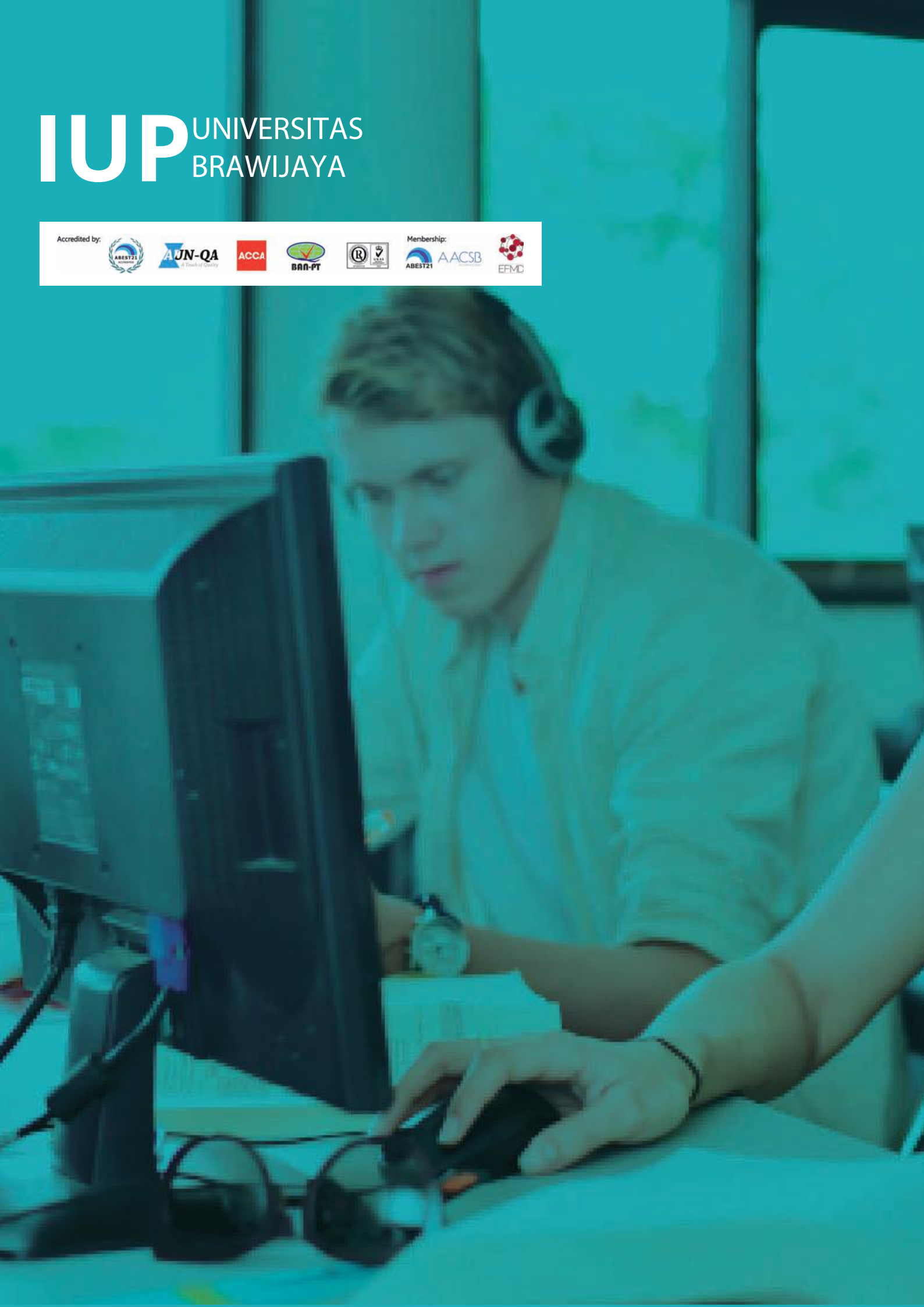

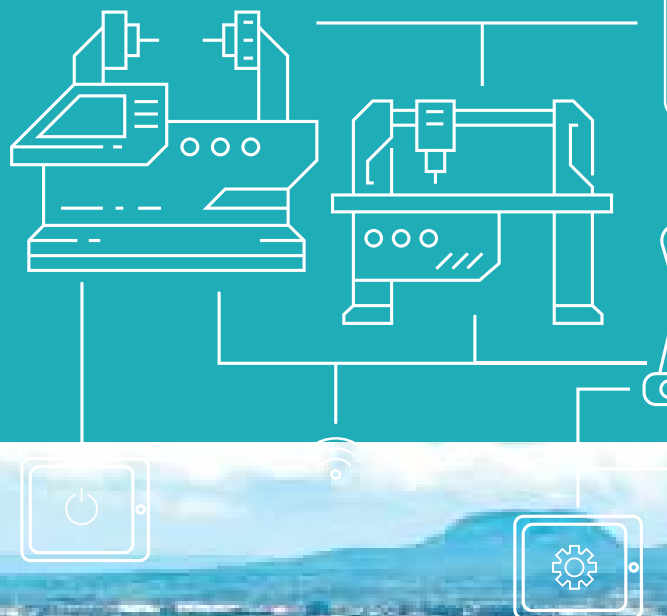

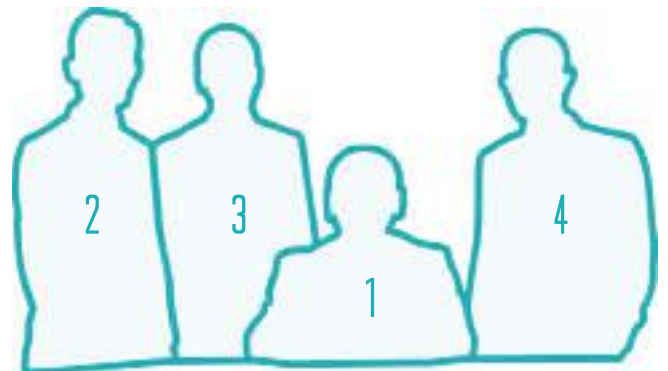

FACULTY OF ECONOMICS AND BUSINESS UNIVERSITAS BRAWIJAYA



The name of Universitas Brawijaya was granted by the President of the Republic of Indonesia through a wire number 258/K/61 sent on 11th July 1961. This name is derived from the title of Kings of Majapahit, a great kingdom in Indonesia from 12th to 15th centuries. UB transformed into a state university on 5th January 1963, following a Presidential Decree issued earlier in the same year. Today, UB is one of the leading universities in Indonesia with more than 62,000 students in various degrees ranging from Diploma, Undergraduate, Master's, Doctorate, and Medical Specialist Programs.



FEB is one of faculties in UB. It was established by the Educational Foundation of Malang College of Economics (EFMCE) on 27th June 1957, under Notary Act number 26 dated 15th August 1957 chaired by Major Polak. Furthermore, on 3rd October 1961, Malang College of Economics became a part of Universitas Brawijaya called Faculty of Economics, Universitas Brawijaya (FE UB) in which it is also one of foundation faculties of UB. At its beginning, FE UB only had two departments namely Economics and Management. Furthermore, the faculty opened a new department named Accounting Department in 1977. Therefore, there are three departments in FE UB, namely Accounting, Management, and Economics. Nowadays, these three departments have fourteen study programs.

To cope with the rapid changes of globalization, FE UB prepared some programs which were in line with the internationalization atmosphere. FE UB started to establish an international undergraduate class in Accounting on 25th July 2007 based on Dean's Decree Number 46A/J10.1.12/SK/2007 in which within two years FE UB had expanded its program into Management and Economics. These programs are well developed and well known as the International Undergraduate Program. In 2009, FE UB became the member of international accreditation organizations, namely the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) and The Alliance on Business Education and Scholarship for Tomorrow, a 21st century (ABEST 21).

The needs of internationalization directed FE UB to make an institutional transformation which was officially conducted on 14th January 2011 through the Rector Decree number 018/SK/2011. Thus, FE UB officially changed its name into "Faculty of Economics and Business", abbreviated into FEB. This transformational is needed as a response of the internal and external changes, involving environment, science, and the demand of the international accreditation.

Nowadays, FEB UB has become one of the best business schools in Indonesia with 4,785 students including Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programs. Twelve FEB UB study programs have achieved "A" accreditation from National Accreditation Agency for Higher Education (for undergraduate, master's, and doctorate programs). In addition, all Master's Program have been granted international accreditation from ABEST21. Furthermore, Undergraduate Program in Accounting has achieved the Association of Certified Chartered Accountant (ACCA) accreditation, and as for Undergraduate Program in Economics, it has been certified by Asian University Network Quality Assurance (AUN QA). All of these achievements prove that FEB UB is a reputable school of business in national and international level.



INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM



International Undergraduate Program (IUP) is an undergraduate program offered by FEB UB specially designed to meet the demand of the society on the international atmosphere classes. It is also one of FEB UB internationalization programs. FEB UB believes that innovation, skills, competencies, IT development, and more improvement areas become the main concern of the 4.0 revolution industry. IUP FEB UB answers this challenge in the field of business economics by providing three specialty programs which are Accounting, Management, and Economics-Finance and Banking which have been awarded "A" accreditation from National Accreditation Agency for higher education. All classes in IUP are conducted in English and to perceive the internationalization atmosphere and enhance the knowledge, all students are obliged to take overseas programs at FEB UB partner universities abroad, namely Overseas Academic Program.

IUP curricula are also designed to meet the international standards; thus IUP also accepts international students who want to take exchange, double degree, or full time study. In spite of having considerably curricula and programs, IUP FEB UB provides some supporting facilities, for instance library, self-access center, IDX stock market, green area, classrooms equipped with air conditioners and LCD, 24 hours internet access (Wi-Fi), sport centers, dormitories/ student housing, computer, banking, and entrepreneurship laboratories, etc. In addition, FEB UB is located in Malang, East Java, Indonesia which is well known with its fresh air and friendly environment. Therefore, IUP FEB UB is an incredibly destination for either domestic or international Senior High School graduates to take higher education.



UP

OVERSEAS ACADEMIC PROGRAM (OAP)

IUP FEB UB obliges all of its students to take OAP. It aims at providing students broader views of International practices and experiences of trans-national academic, cultural and business traditions of FEB UB university partners abroad.



DOUBLE DEGREES (1-2 YEARS)

A program where the students take double degree in two universities consisting of 4 semesters in UB and 2 up to 4 semesters in partner universities abroad

EXCHANGE (1 SEMESTER)

A program allowing transfer credits for students taking a semester study at the partner universities abroad

INTERNSHIP (1-6 MONTHS)

A program encouraging students either to have job experiences in the overseas institution or to take part in the research center of the university partner abroad for 1 up to 6 months

INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL (3-4 WEEKS)

A program designed for International students either coming from university partner or private interest, who are interested in getting international academic exposures and experiences at FEB UB and Indonesia.

The objective of this program is to provide a global understanding of Indonesian economics, society, politics, and foreign policy. Courses designed for three up to four weeks and students will receive academic transcripts at the end of the program. The result of the program might be used as credit transfer to the origin university.

COURSES DESCRIPTION

Entrepreneurship, Leadership, and Business Communication

This course discusses the practice of entrepreneurship, and related issues including leadership and business communication. Some field trips are arranged to visit some industries to learn the entrepreneurship and leadership skills.

International Business: Asian Perspective

This course discusses business issues in the globalization era with the case study of Asian countries, particularly Indonesian. Some field trips are arranged to visit business operated in Indonesia.

Indonesian Business and Economy

The course aims at explaining and assessing the functions of the Indonesian business and economy. It is intended for students who are seeking a broad understanding on how the economy and business works in the case of developing country, particularly Indonesia. Its emphasis will be placed on the related topics of current economic issues, institutions, and policies of Indonesian business and economy.

Indonesian Language and Culture

This subject aims at creating sufficient literacy to students about the basic Indonesian language, social, and business activities. This literacy will be used as a very useful provision for students to enter the business era.

SCHOLARSHIP

UB provides various scholarships, from governmental and non-governmental institutions and companies. The administration, registration, and selection for UB scholarships are held online and offline. Meanwhile, both UB and FEB UB provides scholarships for international students who are able to pass the selection processes determined by the university and faculty.



HOW TO APPLY

1. Local/ Domestic Students

This admission is for prospective students who hold Indonesian Citizenship/Indonesia Permanent Resident conducted through UB Self-Selection Test.

- Requirements:
 - a. Indonesian Citizenship;
 - b. Graduated from Senior High School, Vocational School, or Overseas School (candidate graduated from overseas schools must complete his/her application by submitting the high school diploma equivalent from Ministry of Education and Culture);
 - c. Graduated from Senior High School for three years maximum graduation period;
 - d. Already taken the Joint Admission Selection of State Universities (SBMPTN) as one of the selection criteria is based on the result of SBMPTN exam.
- Admission Tests

The selection process for the IUP Admission test are divided into two:

 - a. The result of SBMPTN test;
 - b. The result of the Interview (conducted in English)

- How to Apply

Admission selection for the IUP can only be accessed via <http://selma.ub.ac.id/>, involving procedure for registration application, examination, and its result.

2. International Students

Eligibility for Admission:

- Candidates will be regarded as an international applicant if he/she does not hold Indonesian nationality.
- Demonstrate good academic competence which is proven with a high academic merit. International applicants should apply directly to UB by filling the online application form and submitting a set of necessary documents. Documents that should be Prepared for the Online Registration:
 - a. Please prepare the following documents before performing online registration.
 - b. Current color photograph, close up, with red background.
 - c. Copy of English proficiency test certificate (TOEFL/ others).
 - d. Copy of passport
- The eligibility for admission is based on a desk evaluation conducted by the UB's admission committee on candidates' academic achievement. The undergraduate program admission requires a good academic performance in high school or college. There is no entry test for admission unless a special condition occurred.
- International applicants must meet the academic and language requirements and commit to comply with particular regulations of Indonesian government related to education policy in order to apply for a degree at Universitas Brawijaya.
- International applicants should demonstrate English language proficiency minimum International TOEFL (ITP) score of 500/IELTS overall score of 5.5 (international program/in English) or should demonstrate Bahasa Indonesia proficiency minimum (regular program/in Bahasa Indonesia).

LIBRARY

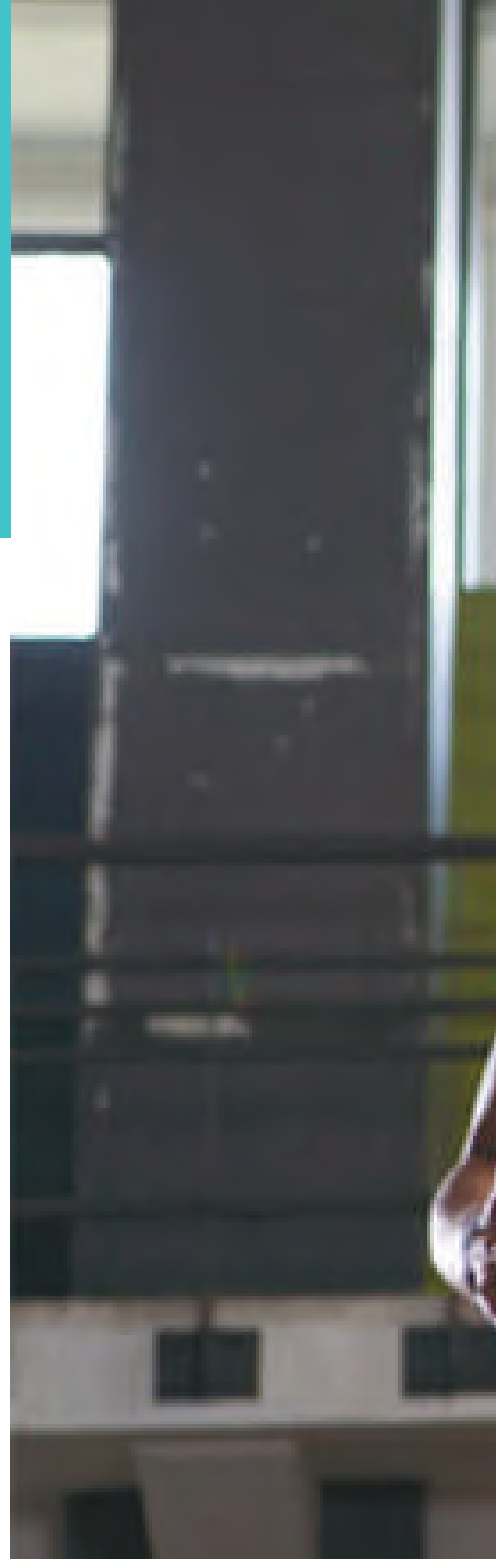

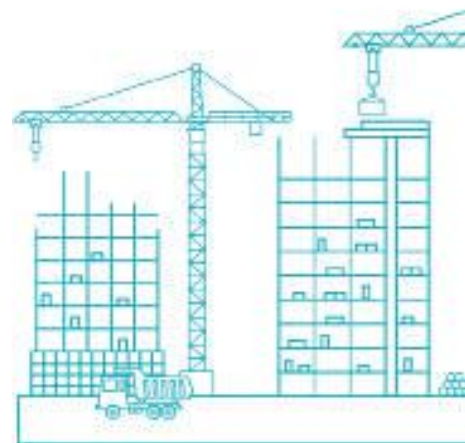
