

Course Information: Evolutionary Game Theory

Lecture

The course takes place each Tuesday at 10am via Zoom. Therefore, I kindly request all students to familiarize themselves with Zoom in order to attend classes.

Examination

40% Presentation; 60% Exam.

Student Presentation:

Students are grouped in order to present one of the listed topics (*The topic list is released after the first lecture*).

Topic allocation:

1. Each student writes an Email with a preference list of the existing topics until the 23.04.2020.
2. Students are grouped to topics according to a mechanism that is based on:
 - a. Preferences
 - b. Order in which preferences are handed in.
3. The exact date of presentation is announced one week before. However, the rough schedule is already provided.

Expectations:

1. The basic intuitions and ideas of the literature are conveyed to the fellow students in an understandable way.
2. Provision of a handout with the most important results/insights.

Grading:

The group can decide on which group member(s) will present. However, all group members obtain the same grade for the presentation.

Exam:

Time and Date:

The exam takes place on the last Tuesday of the respective semester. The duration of the exam is 90 minutes.

Content:

The exam comprises all topics discussed in the seminar. Students are expected to be able to apply concepts of evolutionary game theory to solve economic problems.

Form of examination:

The exam is an open-book exam and thus allows you to take notes, texts or resource materials into the exam.
