Teaching and credits:

- Take a seminar in Sustainability and Behavioral Economics (6 ECTS)
- Participate in a German language course (beginner level, 4 ECTS)
- Meet teachers and fellow students in online-sessions beforehand
- Enjoy an interactive international learning experience with international students and students from Kassel

Costs and support:

- No tuition fees
- Students cover their own travel expenses, housing, and costs of living

FAQ - APPLICATION

❖ HOW DO I APPLY?

You must apply at your home university. Make sure that you do not miss the local deadlines.

FAQ - VISA

❖ WHEN SHOULD I APPLY FOR A VISA?

Receiving a visa may take considerable time – especially if you do not hold a US-American, British or Canadian passport. Please make an appointment at the German embassy or consulate **as soon as you are accepted**. We will issue the necessary official invitation beforehand.



FAQ – ACCOMMODATION & LIVING COSTS

❖ DOES THE UNIVERSITY HELP ME FIND HOUSING?

We arrange housing with local host families (at 600-650 € for the full period).

❖ DO I NEED TO PAY BEFOREHAND?

We will ask you for a deposit of 300 € for housing after you are accepted.

❖ CAN YOU HELP ME WITH AN INSURANCE?

We can arrange health and personal liability insurance for you (at approximately 50 €).

❖ WHAT OTHER LIVING COSTS SHOULD I EXPECT?

With another 550 - 600 €, the daily living expenses should be covered (not including health insurance, housing or travel).



FAQ – TRAVEL

❖ HOW DO I GET TO KASSEL?

The most convenient airport to fly into is Frankfurt International Airport (FRA). You can use local trains for onward travel to Kassel.

❖ HOW DO I FIND MY GUEST FAMILY'S HOUSE?

We will arrange a pickup-service at the Kassel train station (Kassel-Wilhelmshöhe).

❖ HOW DO I GET AROUND KASSEL?

We recommend to get the "Deutschlandticket" (currently 49 € per month). It allows free travel with local transportation. It is valid in all local trains all over Germany.



FAQ – STUDIES

❖ WHICH COURSES CAN I TAKE?

- A seminar on Sustainability and Behavioral Economics (6 ECTS) and
- A German course (absolute beginners, 4 ECTS)

❖ HOW DO I EARN CREDITS?

Participation is mandatory in both courses (and the course-related excursion to Wartburg). In the seminar, you have to give a presentation in class and write a term paper (after the summer school ends).

❖ DO I HAVE TO PAY ANY TUITION FEE?

No.

❖ WHO ELSE IS PARTICIPATING?

Students from the University of Kassel and selected partner universities.
