(Post-)Doktorandinnen Stammtisch & SFB ELCH: Gender equality in Physics: Field Report of the European funded GENERA Project

Abstract

Gender equality is nothing less than one of the 17 goals that the United Nations (UN) has set itself for sustainable development. For the European Union (EU), gender equality in science is one of five priorities in shaping the European Research Area "to end the waste of talent which we cannot afford and to diversify views and approaches in research and foster excellence". In pursuit of this noble goal, the EU promotes, among other things, consortia of scientific institutes in their efforts to implement gender equality. Since September 2015, the GENERA project has been active to raise awareness in physics of the traditional under-representation of women and to define measures to promote gender diversity and excellence. The claim and reality of implementing equality with the help of the GENERA project are clearly presented and discussed in the form of an experience report.
