

**Call for Participation:**  
**Sustainable agricultural practices in the Mediterranean (P25) (6 credits)**  
**Weeklong excursion to Tunisia, 2 - 10 March 2024**



In order to take part in the excursion, you should:

- have a study focus aspects of agriculture, water- and soil related topics, geography, or social aspects relevant to arid and semi-arid regions such as North Africa and/or Tunisia
- be proficient in English (additionally, French language skills also welcome)
- be prepared to contribute up to €200 each to the total cost of the excursion (potentially lower, funding requests pending)

The excursion deals with sustainable agricultural practices in water-scarce regions in the Maghreb (North African region) within the framework of a supervised interdisciplinary fieldtrip. The study tour includes collaboration with Tunisian students and researchers, visiting local agricultural landscapes, and offers insights into the political, socio-economic and geographical conditions of agriculture in the country, the Maghreb and the greater Mediterranean region.
