



## **Submission Guidelines for Themed Issue Authors**

The Journal of Microscopy is the oldest journal dedicated to the science of microscopy and the only peer-reviewed publication of the Royal Microscopical Society. It publishes papers that report on the very latest developments in microscopy such as advances in microscopy techniques or novel areas of application. We will also consider research papers in which the application of state-of-the-art microscopy is a key aspect of the research findings.

Manuscripts will be considered only on the understanding that they have not been published and are not being considered for publication elsewhere. Papers will only be published on the recommendation of suitable referees. Authors must affirm that they have been engaged in the conception and design of an investigation and/or the analysis and interpretation of the data, that they have helped in the drafting of the manuscript and that they have seen the final version.

Papers, including short technical notes, should be submitted to the Journal of Microscopy for the "EMABM (19th Euroseminar on Microscopy Applied to Building Materials) 2024"

Special Issue by 31 July 2023.

**Papers should be submitted online at** https://wiley.atyponrex.com/journal/JMI. Full instructions are available on the site and a user ID and password can be obtained on the first visit.

Authors must ensure they select 'Themed Issue Paper' as the Paper Type during the submission process and choose "EMABM (19th Euroseminar on Microscopy Applied to Building Materials) 2024" as the special issue.

## WHAT SHOULD YOU SUBMIT?

- 1 Word document file containing just the text of the article: This file should include ALL text, including references and figure captions (as a list at the end). The file should NOT include any images.
- All figures as separate clearly labeled files: Original high resolution image files should be submitted (.eps or .tiff). Images should not be embedded into word documents.
- Tables should be submitted as individual word documents (1 word doc file per table).
- A Word document containing a second abstract or "lay description" in easy to understand language for non-experts.
- LaTeX files: Please submit a PDF of the entire paper plus the original .tex and image files.
- Supplementary material, such as movies, can also be submitted along with the paper.

All files submitted should be of publication quality.

All files submitted will automatically be converted to one PDF for review purposes.
