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Praveen Jha superannuated as Sukhamoy Chakravarty Chair Professor of Economics in January 2026, from the Centre for Economic Studies and Planning, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. His areas of teaching and research interests include: Political Economy of Development, with particular reference to Labour, Agriculture and Education. His other areas of interest are Natural Resources, Public Finance and History of Economic Thought.

He was also an Adjunct Professor at the Centre for Informal Sector and Labour Studies (CISLS), School of Social Sciences, Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), New Delhi, India. He has also been a Visiting Fellow/Professor to several Institutions/ Universities, including University of Bremen, Germany; Tianjin University of Finance and Economics, Tianjin, China; Rhodes University, Makhanda (Grahamstown), South Africa; Sam Moyo African Institute of Agrarian Studies, Harare, Zimbabwe; International Labour Organisation, Geneva, Switzerland; Leipzig University, Germany; and Kassel University, Germany.

He has been associated with several research studies with UN institutions such as the ILO, the UNICEF, the UNDP, and the FAO etc., and several think tanks in India and abroad. Apart from being one of the founding editors of the journal, *Agrarian South: Journal of Political Economy*, he is on the editorial/advisory board of a few well-known journals. He has authored/edited more than twenty books and monographs, and has published well over hundred articles in journals and as book chapters. His latest book is a co-edited (Sudhanshu Bhushan) volume titled *Critical Explorations in Social Sciences: Essays presented to Utsa Patnaik and Prabhat Patnaik*, which was released in December 2025.
