

Thinking and acting at the University of Kassel are characterized by open-mindedness towards the problems and challenges in society and nature. Thus, the interdisciplinary academic program with seminars taught in English and German focuses on environmental & technological aspects of Architecture, Engineering, Business and Politics.

Furthermore, Intercultural Communication, Interactive History and Politics, and Erlebte Landeskunde are considered vital components of the program.

Classes are taught by high profile faculty members and include field trips and cultural interaction in Kassel.

ISU Kassel focuses on highly motivated and qualified students and researchers with an interest in German language and culture and the offered disciplines.

In addition to the study program, students will

- attend an intensive German language course offered at three different levels, including beginners
- earn 3 ECTS Credit Points per seminar and for the language course
- have a German 'Tandem-Language-Partner' to meet up and practice their German
- participate in hands-on media and culture workshops (e.g. shooting a video, publish an online magazine, or examine modern art in Kassel's public areas)

- enjoy an exciting cultural and leisure program (trip to Weimar, optional trip to Berlin, city and fairy tale tour in Kassel, climbing the Herkules monument, theater, cinema, closing reception in the city hall, hiking and canoe tours, sports, swimming, BBQ, etc.)
- study during the Kassel semester on a picturesque and lively campus in the heart of the city
- live with German host families and meet Kassel students in selected classes, in campus cafés, and during leisure activities. Students will practice their German in personal contact and learn about everyday life in Germany through firsthand experience

ISU Kassel combines high quality education, credit points, priceless personal experience, and new terrific impressions about Germany and Europe. In the geographical center of Germany and the continent, Kassel is a great starting point for a trip around Europe.

The program fee includes two seminars (20h each), one language course (40 hours), two workshops (8 hours each), excursions, the cultural program, accommodation with two meals per day, free public transportation in Kassel, health and liability insurance.
