Experience of difference: Behaviour expectations towards students and lecturers

Nóra is spending a semester as a visiting student at a German university and has considerable problems understanding the lectures. After each class, she stays back with a number of unanswered questions, wishing to discuss these questions with someone. However, she does not know where to turn.
