Publication of your **doctoral thesis** on KOBRA

Maintained by Kassel University Library, [KOBRA](#) offers the organizational and technical framework for the electronic publication of your doctoral thesis. KOBRA is both an electronic publishing platform and a digital archive for academic publications from members of the University of Kassel.

The advantages for you as a doctoral student and for users are

- Publishing in KOBRA is fast, free, and uncomplicated.
- When publishing in KOBRA, the number of deposit copies is reduced to just three (cf. [Regulations for deposit copies for doctoral theses](#)).
- Long-term archiving and availability of your doctoral thesis and the citability of the work are guaranteed under a globally unique identifier (DOI).
- Your thesis will be deposited in the German National Library (DNB) and can be accessed at any time and from anywhere via the Internet, e.g. via [KARLA](#), the catalogue of the University Library of Kassel, and the [WorldCat](#), or the DNB.
- The content in KOBRA can be found via the usual search engines (Google, MSN, Bing, MetaGer, Qwant, etc.) as well as via special scientific services (OAIster, BASE, GoogleScholar). A full text search is also possible.

Registration

You can log in to KOBRA via your university account ("uk number" without @...). If you do not have a university account, you can register with KOBRA as an external user (<https://kobra.uni-kassel.de/login>).

Document submission – Start of a new publication

After the login you can upload your doctoral thesis. This will be stored in a temporary collection at first. After the formal check (cf. [Checking the submitted document](#)), the document will be published in the appropriate collection. Already at the beginning of the publishing process, a DOI is reserved for your work, so you can integrate the DOI into the document before the final upload. In addition to regular submission, there is also the "Komfortablieferung" (convenience submission) option, where you only need to enter minimal information. The KOBRA team will complete the metadata.

License terms

The agreement to the license terms is integrated in the publishing process. The terms and conditions can be found at <https://kobra.uni-kassel.de/page/license> (german only). In addition to this so-called "deposit license", which is necessary for publishing your work on KOBRA, any [Creative Commons License](#) can be granted. With this license you define in detail the conditions of use and further processing of your publication.

Checking the submitted document

The submitted document will be checked by us with regard to some formal information on the title page (e.g. the date of the oral examination must be mentioned in the thesis) and technically processed. We will then send you a link to the version we have edited, which you can download there. This gives you the opportunity for a final check before the thesis is published on KOBRA for everyone to see. In KOBRA, standardized keywords from the Integrated Authority File ([GND](#)) are then added. The free keywords you have assigned are retained and can also be searched.

Your rights as author

The publication in KOBRA does not prevent further publication in printed or electronic form. The authors' copyrights are preserved. The authors themselves are responsible for observing the copyrights and exploitation rights of third parties. When concluding publishing contracts, you should therefore obtain a further, non-exclusive right of use in accordance with the recommendations of the Wissenschaftsrat.

Special regulations apply to the electronic publication of theses for which the publisher with whom you have already published your thesis has the right of first utilisation: in general, publication in KOBRA is no longer possible. However, some publishers allow electronic publication parallel to the print version. If in doubt, ask the publisher and have the right to publish by the university confirmed.

For the re-use of articles in the context of cumulative theses, Publishers often have regulations that are more accommodating. If you are unsure whether and in what form you are allowed to republish articles within your cumulative thesis, please contact publikationsdienste@uni-kassel.de.

Regulations for deposit copies for doctoral theses

According to the [General Provisions for Doctoral Degrees at the University of Kassel dated 14 July 2021](#) (non-official translation), the publication obligation is completely fulfilled by the KOBRA publication. If the publication is carried out in accordance with the General Provisions for [Doctorates 2016](#) (German only), three printed deposit copies must be submitted in addition to the online version.

The printed copies must be identical in content and pagination to the online edition. We therefore advise you to complete the online publication first and then place a print order. Please hand in the bound copies (no ring binding) to the [Dissertation Office of the University Library](#).

Research Data

If you want to publish research data on your thesis, you can use the [DaKS](#) data repository. The DOI of the data should be entered in the thesis and in the KOBRA metadata. The KOBRA DOI should also be entered in [DaKS](#) to ensure a two-way link to the publication. DOI pre-registration is possible in both systems.
