New Version of the Special Provisions for Doctoral Degrees at Kunsthochschule Kassel (School of Art and Design) at the University of Kassel related to the General Provisions for Doctoral Degrees at the University of Kassel (AB-PromO) dated 14 July 2021

§ 1 Scope of application

According to Section 24 of the AB-PromO, Kunsthochschule Kassel at the University of Kassel is issuing the following Special Provisions to complement the General Provisions for Doctoral Degrees at the University of Kassel (AB-PromO), both in their latest version.

§ 2 Doctoral degrees, doctoral degree subjects

According to Section 1 Para. 2 of the AB-PromO, Kunsthochschule Kassel awards the academic doctoral degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Dr. phil.) in the academic subjects of art history / art, art education and design sciences following completion of a proper doctoral procedure.

§ 3 Doctoral examination committee

According to Section 2 Para. 1 of the AB-PromO, Kunsthochschule Kassel must form a doctoral examination committee for the doctoral degrees that it awards.

§ 4 Acceptance requirements

- 1) According to Section 3 Para. 1 of the AB-PromO, the crucial precondition for acceptance as a doctoral candidate is the completion of a relevant academic degree in the subjects of art history / art, art education and design sciences or in related subjects. In any cases of doubt, the doctoral examination committee must check using a written statement by the supervisor whether the current degree courses can be viewed as related subjects for the degree, which is supposed to create the conditions for the doctoral degree in the relevant doctoral degree subject.
- 2) Candidates with a degree in line with Section 3 Para. 2 of the AB-PromO are accepted as a doctoral candidate after successfully passing an assessment of eligibility. The assessment of eligibility procedure is conducted on the basis of the written application documents. The assessment of eligibility takes place according to the examination regulations for the relevant subject. Graded coursework and examination work must be completed. The scope of this should normally not exceed 60 credits. The doctoral examination committee must set and communicate the type and scope of the coursework and examination work to be completed. In any cases of doubt, the doctoral examination committee can ask the supervisor for a statement about the reasons that qualify the candidate for a doctoral degree in the intended doctoral degree subject.
- 3) Graduates from art degree courses can be accepted for the assessment of eligibility in the sense of Section 3 Para. 2 e of the AB-Promo, provided that they provide evidence of having completed subject-specific academic coursework and examination work within a scope of at least 30 credits.
- 4) The grade "good" is set as the minimum grade in the university degree for acceptance as a doctoral candidate. The doctoral examination committee may depart from this in well-founded exceptional

cases.

§ 5 Extending the deadline

To enable a decision to be made about extending the deadline, the candidate must submit the thesis work already completed and the supervisor must also issue a statement.

§ 6 Studies supporting the doctoral degree

- 1) Doctoral candidates at Kunsthochschule Kassel may attend a degree course to support their doctoral degree in line with Section 20 of the AB-PromO in the form of further training related to their research work in the relevant doctoral degree subject amounting to between 15 and 30 credits.
- 2) The content of the studies supporting the doctoral degree must be set with the responsible supervisor.

§ 7 Temporary provisions

The Special Provisions for Doctoral Degrees at Kunsthochschule Kassel at the University of Kassel from 15 April 2009 until 31 March 2030 continue to apply for doctoral candidates who were accepted before these provisions took effect.

§ 7 Taking effect / ceasing to be valid

- 1) This new version of the Special Provisions for Doctoral Degrees at the Kunsthochschule Kassel at the University of Kassel takes effect on the day after its publication in the Official Gazette at the University of Kassel.
- 2) The Special Provisions for Doctoral Degrees at the Kunsthochschule Kassel at the University of Kassel in the version dated 6 December 2006 cease to be valid on the day after the publication of this new version in the Official Gazette at the University of Kassel.
- 3) The Special Provisions for Doctoral Degrees at the Kunsthochschule Kassel at the University of Kassel in the version dated 15 April 2009 cease to be valid on 31 March 2030.
