

Funding for research stays abroad for researchers with a PhD

Postdoctoral researchers at the University of Kassel (up until 6 years after completing their PhD) can apply for financial support for international conference participation, research trips, workshops or stays with mentors abroad.

The funding includes a lump sum for travel and accommodation expenses and, if applicable, the (partial) payment of participation fees based on the DAAD scholarship rates (max. 80% of the possible DAAD funding). The maximum funding limit is € 3,000 per application. A maximum of one stay per calendar year can be funded.

Application deadline: At any time, at least 6 weeks before the planned stay

Additional application documents (Please submit those together with the completed application form in one PDF file via e-mail to eint-funding@uni-kassel.de):

- Curriculum vitae
- Planned programme for the research stay or conference/workshop programme
- Letter of invitation from the host institution including the start and end dates or confirmation of conference/workshop duration
- PhD certificate or other confirmation of completed PhD
- (if applicable) participation fee amount
- For conference participation: Proof of an active role (workshop, presentation...) or explanation of why the stay is nevertheless essential
