Job suggestions during Corona Pandemic

- 1. Supermarkets, drugstores, other retailers such as bakeries and butchers The jobs are filling the shelves, unpacking the new goods, cashiers.
- → Simply inquire directly on-site or have a look at the job portal of Lidl, Rewe, Aldi etc.
- Delivery, Mailman jobs
 Delivery services, courier services, retailers in e-commerce (e.g. Deutsche Post).
- 3. Customer Service/ Call Center
 At the moment, there are cancellations or re-booking situations in many areas,
 therefore, demand for workers in handling customer complaints is rapidly increasing.
- 4. Jobs with a medical background, in the medical field or in health facilities. e.g. https://goodjobs.eu/de/Heldinnengesucht
- 5. Seasonal workers are currently being sought for on many farms. German is not compulsory, and the job pays well (Minimum Wage 9.35 €/hour). However, the farms are mostly far away or out of town, you may want to check if they offer meals and accommodation.

Our tips

- Learn how to be ready for job application. Join our <u>webinars</u> to train yourself on how to write CV, motivation letter, what to say during an interview and ask questions.
- Training new skills. There are a lot of online courses with the possibility of getting a certificate after you finish. This is a good chance to build up new skills.

 e.g. starting new language course. Visit Language Center for more details.

Career Service

- Look for jobs in local print media, for example: in the local daily newspaper HNA or in the free newspaper Extra tips (delivered twice a week to all households).
- Enter the keyword 'Kassel' in combination with part-time job, mini-job, temporary work, student jobs or freelance work in Internet search engines
- Have a look at the above lists. Bear in mind that some jobs are good if you need quick
 money (e.g. waiter, call center, working in the kitchen or in the canteen), but they do
 not help you professionally. However, jobs such as, student assistant, working student
 or part-time job at an online-marketing agency, which have a connection to what you
 study and the job itself helps you to find a good job after your studies.
- Consider volunteering jobs, which do not pay you, BUT they can give you a certificate and it helps your CV looks much more attractive It shows that you are socially active, which is important to some organizations.
- Prepare yourself for new job opportunities. Searching for position, doing research about companies, cities that you want to apply and work for in the future.
- Visit <u>Studentenwerk</u> if you need other helps.

As you may see, during Corona crisis, companies are losing money and they also minimized their recruitment plan. We hope that with our suggestions, you will find a way to make the best out of this situation.
